





















## Current rules to handle the COVID-19-pandemic in Saxony-Anhalt and Magdeburg (valid until February 24, 2022):

<p><b>2G:</b> Access for</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- vaccinated people with vaccine certificate</li> <li>- recovered people with proof of recovery</li> <li>- children and adolescents under 18 years of age (during school vacation a negative COVID test is required)</li> <li>- people who cannot get vaccinated for medical reasons (a doctor's certificate and a negative COVID test are required)</li> </ul> <p>Hygiene measures like mask-wearing and social distancing rules have to be followed.</p>  <p>vaccinated or recovered</p>	<p><b>2G</b> applies to indoor spaces:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- shopping, except shops for basic supply</li> <li>- events with more than 50 people</li> <li>- indoor bars and restaurants</li> <li>- gyms and swimming pools, dancing and sports classes, saunas etc.</li> <li>- cultural and leisure activities such as museums, cinemas, theaters, etc.</li> <li>- hotels, guest houses and other accommodations for tourist visitors</li> <li>- sociocultural centers, community centers, meeting places for senior citizens, etc.</li> <li>- gambling houses, casinos and amusement halls</li> <li>- bus trips, boat tours, sight-seeing tours and similar touristic activities</li> </ul>	    
<p><b>2G+:</b> Access for</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- vaccinated and recovered people who show a negative COVID test</li> <li>- children and adolescents under 18 years of age (during school vacation a negative COVID test is required)</li> <li>- people with booster injection (3 injections) and vaccine certificate are free from providing a COVID test (this applies as of the day of the third injection)</li> </ul> <p>Mask-wearing and social distancing rules can be eased.</p>  <p>vaccinated or recovered</p>	<p><b>2G+</b> mandatory for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- choirs</li> <li>- fairs</li> <li>- major cultural and sporting events</li> </ul> <p>Events, cultural centers, restaurants, touristic activities and leisure facilities can make use of 2G+ voluntarily.</p>	 
<p><b>Please note:</b> If a test is required, either a PCR test (not older than 48 hours) or a certificate of an antigen test can be presented. In some cases, a self-test can be carried out on site. For testing sites click <a href="#">here</a>.</p>		
<p><b>3G:</b> Access for</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- vaccinated people with vaccine certificate</li> <li>- recovered people with proof of recovery</li> <li>- people showing a negative COVID test</li> <li>- children and adolescents under 18 years of age (during school vacation a negative COVID test is required)</li> <li>- people who cannot test for COVID-19 for medical reasons</li> </ul>  <p>vaccinated or recovered</p>	<p><b>3G</b> applies to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- outdoor sports</li> <li>- archives and libraries</li> <li>- in the workplace</li> <li>- trade fairs and exhibitions</li> <li>- local public transport</li> <li>- close contact services (hairdresser, beauty and nail salons, massage parlors, chiropody, piercing and tattoo studios etc. as well as medical therapies like physiotherapy, occupational therapy or speech therapy)</li> </ul>	  

	<p><b>Child care</b></p> <p>Children's day-care is open for all children.</p>		<p><b>Schools</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- mandatory daily COVID test for students and teachers</li> <li>- compulsory attendance is suspended (upon request)</li> <li>- mandatory mask-wearing for all grades, also in class</li> </ul>
	<p><b>Private get-togethers</b></p> <p><u>Vaccinated and recovered:</u> with 10 persons at maximum</p> <p>⇒ It is recommended to meet as few people as possible. This group of people should be held constant.</p> <p><u>Neither vaccinated nor recovered:</u> One household is allowed to meet at maximum 2 people from one other household</p> <p>Children under the age of 14 are not counted.</p> <p>Please test for COVID before meeting family or friends.</p>		<p><b>Mandatory mask-wearing</b></p> <p>in public transport and shops (medical masks like FFP2- or surgical masks) as well as in public spaces whenever it is impossible to keep a distance of 1,5 meters.</p>
  	<p><b>Please be constantly aware of hygiene measures and observe social distancing rules.</b></p> <p><b>Please make use of the opportunity to get <u>vaccinated</u>.</b></p>
